U.S. Crop Planting Update

USDA reported May 31 that 86% of the U.S. corn crop was planted compared to 97% last year and 95% on average with 66% emerged, compared to 83% last year and 78% on average.

The corn crop condition is 63% good/excellent. Last year's condition at this time was 76% good/excellent. Only 6% of the crop is rated very poor/poor.

The soybean crop is 51% planted, 20 points behind last year and the 5-year average. About 27% of the crop has emerged, compared to 43% last year and 39% on average.

U.S. winter wheat was 72% has headed, compared to 73% last year and 76% on average and 33% of the crop is in good to excellent condition, up 1% from last week.

For spring wheat, 68% is planted, compared to 94% last year and 95% on average and 40% is emerged, compared to 81% both last year and on average.
